





Up 2 points to +63






SMU Buyers Sentiment Index









Overall Demand



Are you seeing demand for your products improving, remaining the same or declining?






Overall Demand History



Steel Price Direction




Steel prices over the next 30 days will go higher, lower or remain the same?






Service Centers- How do you see your customers releases (demand) for the products your company provides this year compared to this time last year?










Manufacturer and Service Center Inventory Buying Patterns


Manufacturer Inventory Buying History






Manufacturer's View of Service Center Selling Prices








Service Center View of Selling Prices



Service Centers- Compared to two weeks ago, how is your company handling spot pricing to your customers at this time?










Service Centers on Manufacturer Orders History






How would you describe domestic mill lead times for new orders placed right now?








Are your foreign steel suppliers quoting you competitive prices for new orders for future delivery?






At this time, are you seeing an increase or decrease in orders from your North American buyers?








