








SMU Future Buyers Sentiment

Future down 4 points to +53






Are you seeing demand for your products improving, remaining the same or declining?


Flat Rolled Prices

What direction do you think flat rolled spot prices will follow over the next 30 to 60 days?




Flat Rolled Prices


Have you placed steel orders for all of your first quarter contract needs?



Q1 Tonnage




Do you anticipate going into 1st Quarter potentially needing to place more "spot" tons than normal?






Manufacturer and Service Center Inventory Buying Patterns





Manufacturer and Service Center Inventory Buying History



Service Center Months on Hand History






Manufacturer's View of Service Center Selling Prices




Manufacturer's View of Service Center Selling Prices History






Service Centers- how is your company handling spot pricing to your customers at this time?






Service Center View of Selling Prices History





Service Centers- Are your manufacturing customers increasing orders, keeping them the same or reducing orders at this time?




Service Centers- How are your manufacturing companies handling orders at this time?




How would you describe domestic mill lead times for new orders placed right now?




Mill Lead Times History







Domestic and Foreign Price Spread




Is the spread between domestic and foreign prices wide enough to justify buying foreign steel?



Domestic and Foreign Price Spread






Is your company entering new foreign orders right now?


