



Up 4 points to +56






SMU Future Buyers Sentiment Index

Down 3 points to +58








Overall Demand History










Where do you think hot rolled prices will average during calendar year 2015?














Service Centers- How do you see your customers releases (demand) for the products your company provides this year compared to this time last year?










Manufacturer and Service Center Inventory Buying Patterns






Manufacturer Inventory Buying History






Service Center Months on Hand History










Service Centers- How is your company handling spot pricing to your customers at this time?









Mill Lead Times




How would you describe domestic mill lead times for new orders placed right now?

















Will receipts of foreign imports cause your company to reduce domestic steel orders?




