


SMU Hot Rolled Price Average











SMU Future Buyers Sentiment Index




Three Month Moving Average at +64.67



Manufacturer and Service Center Inventory Buying Patterns



Infrastructure Investment Creates Economic Growth


- One billion dollars in infrastructure spending requires about 50,000 net tons of steel
- Each trillion dollars invested in infrastructure has the potential to create 11 million jobs over the next decade
- Biden administration actions on taxpayer-funded projects using American steel
- Key issue: How to pay for new bill



Infrastructure Legislation – Opportunities

- Infrastructure investment is a rare bipartisan issue
 - Public polling for infrastructure spending is extremely high
 - Statements by members of Congress range from left to right
 - Business, labor, environmental groups all generally supportive
- Key deadlines approaching
 - Surface transportation authorizations expire on September 30, 2021
 - Impending insolvency of Highway Trust Fund in 2022

Highway Trust Fund Approaches Insolvency Again





Infrastructure Legislation - Challenges to Passage

- Definition of "infrastructure"
 - Traditional definition roads, bridges, transit, airports, water projects
 - Schools, broadband, electric grid
 - Housing, elder care, workforce development
- Financing
 - GOP opposition to any changes to 2017 tax laws
 - Bipartisan hesitancy to adjust gas tax or other user fees
- Politics!!
 - GOP deny Biden/Democrats "win"; 2022 midterm elections




