

Hot-rolled steel prices vs. lead times


SMU's hot-rolled steel prices and lead times, with data through Jan. 9, 2024.


Prime scrap prices in January will be:





Future hot rolled prices


Where do you think HRC prices will be in two months?






Hot rolled inflection point

When do you think steel prices will peak, and why?



Steel mill lead times by product


SMU lead times on new steel orders by product through Jan. 3, 2024.





Steel mill negotiations


SMU's price negotiations on new steel orders by product through Jan. 3, 2024.

Two months from now, will lead times be extending, flat, or contracting?






Compared to two weeks ago, how is your company handling spot pricing to your customers?





Foreign steel competitiveness


Are your foreign steel suppliers quoting you competitive prices for new orders for future delivery?






Service center inventories
